Scope:

Convert unusable basement space of the Historic Heierding Building into a contemporary Materials Library and secondary conference room for Elliott + Associates Architects. Space required new floor surface, water/vapor proofing existing structure, preservation of historically significant artifacts, addition of gypsum ceiling, installation of custom millwork, updating current MEP + FLS, addition of updated lighting, Audio, Glass block skylights/walks at historic areaways, custom interior finishes, and designer furniture.

Program Requirements:

To house product literature, material samples, and provide a work space for the E+AA team to examine, sample and design with materials at hand. To provide an effective and interesting conference area for client and consultant meetings.

Architectural Concept:

The 1,196 SF basement space provides the perfect opportunity for a much needed conference space and materials library. The firm has built a reputation for providing outstanding lighting design. This space also serves as a lighting laboratory for experimentation and the creation of lighting atmospheres for study.


